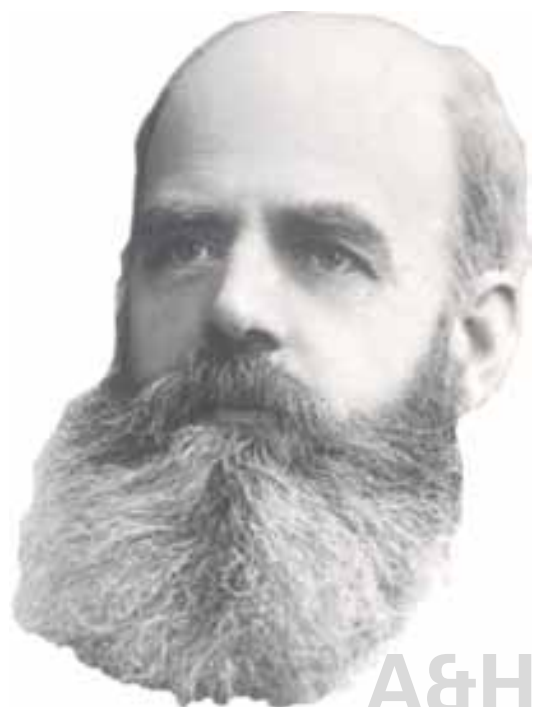

Charles Schilsky
Teacher of Violin at the Elder Conservatorium



Dame Roma Mitchell
Graduate of the University of Adelaide, outstanding scholar, foremost female legal pioneer, first woman judge, first woman State Governor and first woman Chancellor of an Australian University



Edith Dornwell
The first woman graduated by the University of Adelaide in 1885 and first Science graduate



Edward Rennie
Angas Chair in Chemistry at the University of Adelaide appointed 1884



Frank Sandland Hone
Public health and preventive medicine reformer and Lecturer at the University of Adelaide 1916–1931



Fredrick Slaney Poole
Member of the University of Adelaide Council 1890–1895



Frederick Coneybeer
Member of the University of Adelaide Council 1911–1912



Helen Mayo
Pioneer of women's and children's health and University of Adelaide graduate



Henry Scott
University of Adelaide Council member 1879–1881



Kenneth Bickersteth
Member of the University of Adelaide Council 1921–1933



Lord Howard Florey
Graduate of the University of Adelaide and Nobel Laureate for his work on penicillin



Sir Mark Oliphant
Graduate of the University of Adelaide, eminent scientist and Governor of South Australia



Sir Douglas Mawson
Professor of Geology at the University of Adelaide and Antarctic explorer extraordinaire



Sir Joseph Verco
Outstanding medical practitioner and co-founder of the University of Adelaide Medical School



Sir Thomas Elder
Pastoralist, entrepreneur and founding and generous benefactor to the University of Adelaide



Thomas Whittell
Member of the University of Adelaide Council 1877–1879 and 1882–1888



Thorburn Brailsford Robertson
First Professor of Biochemistry at the University of Adelaide, developed mass production of insulin



Veta MacGhey
Educationalist, unionist and graduate of the University of Adelaide



F S Wallis
Member of the University of Adelaide Council 1915–1921
